1. Scholarship Program

The **Hellenic Revitalization Foundation** (HRF) offers scholarships to promote, encourage, induce and advance education at the college and university level.

Scholarship awards are \$500 or \$1,000 based on application ranking and financial need.

2. Eligibility

The HRF is committed to rewarding academic excellence and assisting scholastic achievement for students of Orthodox and / or Greek descent. Special consideration will be shown for students with financial needs (Section 11). Applicants are encouraged to apply for the AHEPA District (www.ahepad6.com) and the National scholarships (www.ahepa.org), as well. Scholarships are very competitive and students, who are awarded a District or National scholarship, will also receive an additional supplemental Chapter scholarship.

Minimum Eligibility Requirements:

- a. Applicants must have maintained a minimum 3.5 GPA.
- b. The applicant is of Orthodox/Greek descent, and a member or son or daughter of a member, in good standing, of AHEPA's James Plevritis – Joseph C. Keane Evzone Chapter, or the New Rochelle Sons of Pericles, and
- c. A high school graduate or a high school senior planning to attend, full time, an accredited college or university during the 2018/2019 academic year.

3. Filing

This scholarship form is applicable for year 2018 only. Applicant is responsible for assembling all of the required items listed below and forwarding them in a single package to the Hellenic Revitalization Found.

Application Requirements' Check list:

- a. **Completed Application**
- b. **Academic Transcript, official**
- c. **Letters of recommendation (Section 13 Letters of Recommendations)**
- d. **Photo:** One wallet size, non-returnable photo, includes authorization for usages should the applicant be awarded the scholarship.
- e. **Financial need certification, if applicable (Section 12 Financial Need)**

The applicant is responsible for the submission of all documents (all are required, except Section 12 Financial Need, which is optional). The completed application and required supportive evidence must be mailed in its entirety by any delivery service that can ascertain proof of delivery **certified mail /return receipt requested, or FedEx** postmarked not later than **May 15, 2018** to address below. The applicant should obtain transcripts and letters of recommendation in sealed envelopes to be included in the scholarship package. If packages are incomplete, student's application will not be considered.

All information will be kept confidential and no items will be returned. Applications postmarked after May 15, 2018 will not be considered. Scholarships will be announced at the Holy Trinity Graduate Luncheon, in early June. All awards will be made payable to the academic institution where the applicant will be attending in Sept. 2018.

4. Type of Scholarships

Special consideration will be given to students applying for scholarships based on financial need. Additional consideration will be given for AHEPA affiliation, extra-curricular activities, community service, and Greek Orthodox Church youth activities. **Check one of the following two categories of consideration:**

- a. **Scholastic Achievement**
- b. **Financial Need and Scholastic Achievement** - Must demonstrate financial need by completing **Section 11** and providing the necessary documentation



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5. Additional Application Requirements

- a. **Academic Transcript - High school seniors** must submit official high school transcript including S.A.T. and / or A.C.T. scores. Transcripts must include GPA and GPA scale (i.e., 3.83 out of 4.0) and weighted GPA, if applicable, along with maximum or current year highest weighted GPA.

Note: All transcripts must be originals, not copies, accompanying the application package, in a separate sealed envelope. S.A.T/A.C.T. must be added to transcripts by Guidance Counselors, or copies of the original score notification may be submitted.

- b. Applicants must include no more than **two letters of recommendation**, i.e. the applicant's teachers, counselors, advisors, professors, pastor, etc. Reference letters from the applicant's relatives/family will not be considered.
